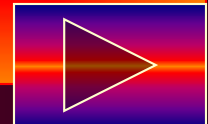


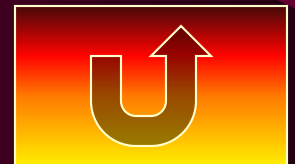


Mahatma Gandhi

- He told his people not to buy things made in foreign countries . He told them to buy things which were made in our country.



- He went to jail and he fought non-violence .
- Finally India got freedom .
- A man shot him and he died. His last word were ‘Hay Ram’.
